

## **HOMEWORK**

## READING

Children are encouraged to read their books that they are provided with each day at home.

The children also have access to a two reading apps which support their reading skills;

- 1. Bug club: this was used in Cherry Class. New logins will be given out in the new school term.
- 2. Epic: an app which you or your child can choose books to read either fiction or non-fiction. This a fun way for your child to read for pleasure.

## **SPELLINGS**

The class will be tested on their spellings every Friday. A paper copy is sent home on a Friday linked to handwriting practice. This gives your child the opportunity to practice their spellings and enhance writing presentation skills at the same time. Children can also can use the online Twinkl spelling game (log ins will be given out at the beginning of term). # BEHAVIOUR

Our class is a positive classroom and good behaviour is rewarded on a daily basis. As you walk around the classroom you may see some of our behaviour management strategies such as team points, Star and Sports Awards, or you may receive a text telling you how wonderful your child has been!

# READING RECORDS AND READING BOOKS

Your child will be provided with a reading record and reading book in the first few weeks back. Please make sure that your child brings them to school every day as someone could listen to them read at any time. The book bands are matched up with your child's reading age, which is assessed at the start of Autumn Term, and the end of each term after that. If your child needs to change their books then please put it on the teacher's table in the morning.

## DROP OFF/PICK UP

Please drop your child off outside the classroom's conservatory doors in the morning. The teacher will be there to welcome the children in and answer any questions. Your child will need to hang their belongings on their peg, put their water bottle in the holder and take their break into the classroom to put their snacks away in their draw. There will be an 'Early Bird' activity for your child to do as soon as they put their things away.

The pick-up point at the end of the day is in the same location. Your child will be called out to you.
