



Free School Meals

Important information

Dear Parents

Currently, all children in Years R, 1 and 2 are entitled to a free school meal, regardless of income. However, if you are eligible for pupil premium and register then you will be able to get other benefits for your child/children such as discounts on breakfast / after school provision, sports clubs, trips etc.

Whatever year group your children are in, please check to see if you may be entitled to pupil premium. This gives your children free school meals in all years (not just Years R-2) and opportunities for other benefits in school.

You may be entitled to Pupil Premium if you are in receipt of any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190 (as at September 2017 but may be subject to change)
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Credit.
