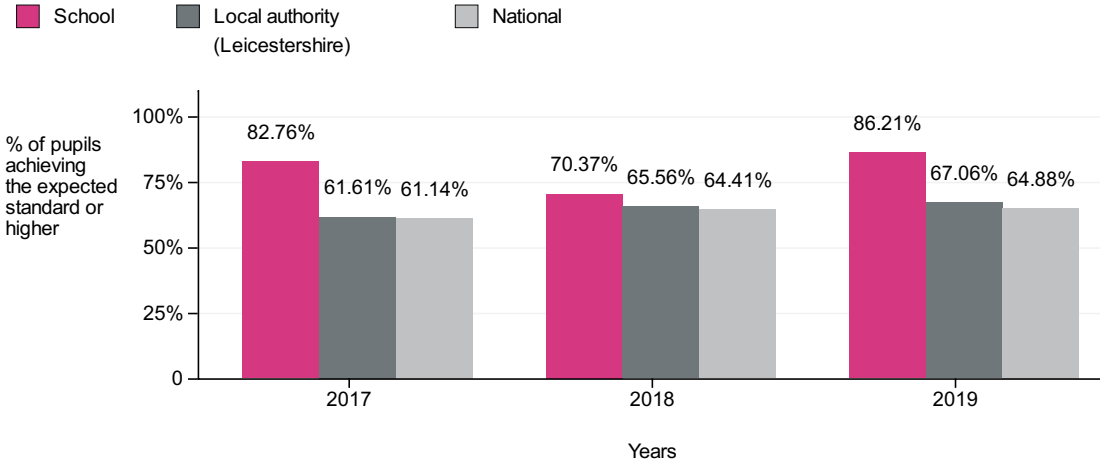

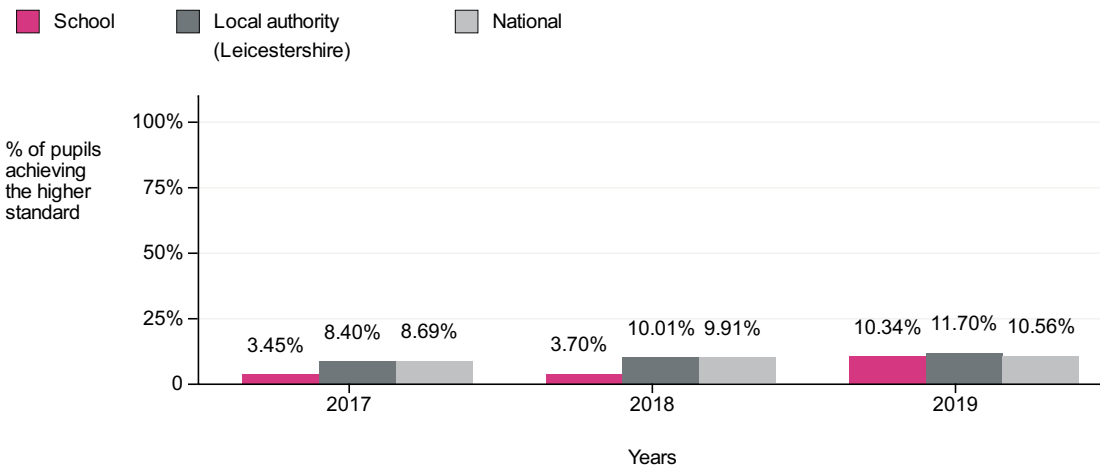


## Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

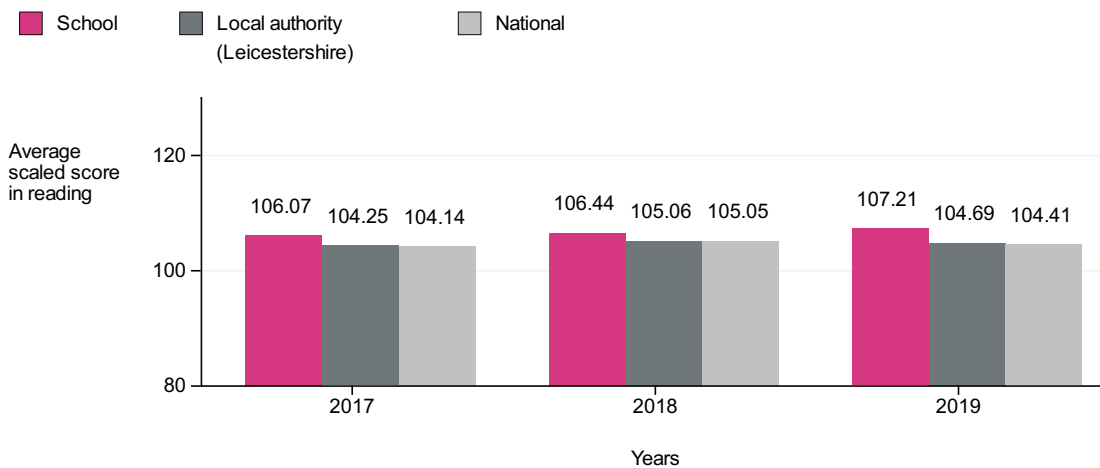
